



The Harry Arthurs Alumni Families Entrance Scholarship

In 1992, the York University Alumni Association founded the Harry Arthurs Alumni Families Entrance Scholarship both to honour York's 30th anniversary in 1989 and to recognize then-president Arthurs' commitment to the University's academic, social, cultural and physical development as fundamental in shaping York's future. The Harry Arthurs Alumni Families Entrance Scholarship is valued at \$24,000 (\$6,000 per year for four years).

Criteria

- Secondary school student seeking admission into the first year of undergraduate study
- Must be a child, grandchild or sibling of a graduate holding a York University degree
- Have a minimum admission average of 90% or equivalent
- Have a demonstrated record of participation and leadership in extracurricular student life

Application Requirements:

You must select the names of the awards you wish to apply for on the Entrance Student Financial Profile (SFP) which you can access through MyFile at yorku.ca/myfile.

You must complete the following sections of the SFP:

- Extracurricular Activities (chronologically starting with the most recent)
- Community Service (chronologically starting with the most recent)
- Personal Statement: provide a brief personal history and describe your best personal achievement(s) and your future plans and ambitions. Your statement must indicate which relative was associated with York University and in what capacity.

Letters of Reference:

In addition to submitting the SFP online, you must mail three letters of reference to the University by the application deadline. The letters should be from individuals who are familiar with your academic work, community service or personal history. Letters of reference from family members are not accepted.
