VALUE

- \$24,000 (\$6,000 for each of four years)
- This award cannot be held with a York University Entrance Scholarship.
- After the first year, this award is renewable for up to three years of undergraduate study on an annual basis provided the recipient maintains a minimum grade point average of 7.8 (B+).

CRITERIA

- Secondary school student seeking admission into the first year of undergraduate study
- Must be a child, grandchild or sibling of a graduate holding a York University degree
- Have a minimum admission average of 90%, or equivalent
- Have a demonstrated record of participation and leadership in extracurricular student life

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

Applications must be received by Student Financial Services by February 1, 2008.
