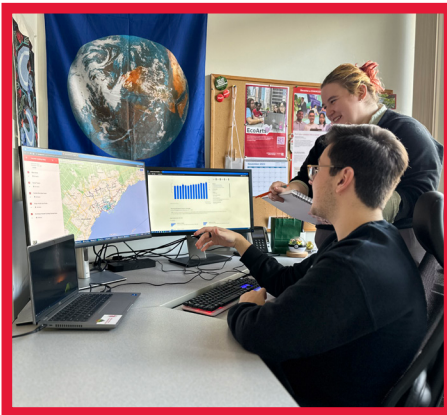


WHY I CHOSE EUC
